Who We Are

Friends Care Community (FCC) is a non-profit health care community for seniors and others who need special care and services. FCC's mission is based on respect for the needs of each individual resident and a comprehensive concern for his or her special needs. Individualized health care is given to each resident, including restorative or supportive assistance. FCC strives to provide a secure and friendly atmosphere with skilled staff and a wide range of activities. FCC has received numerous high ratings as a health care facility and is a trusted partner in serving the wider Yellow Springs Community.

How We Started

Friends Care Community began in 1960 with Arthur Morgan's belief that Yellow Springs should have a nursing home. The Yellow Springs Friends Meeting carried the idea forward with an initial fifty bed facility opening in 1980. The facility grew in 1983 with sixteen additional beds and a variety of new activity spaces. The twenty room Assisted Living Center was added in 1999 and the Independent Living houses built in 2002. In 2003 -2004, the interior of the Extended Care Facility was completely renovated with an emphasis on creating a home-like atmosphere. In 2011, a state-of-the-art Rehabilitation Center was added to the array of services.

In the spirit of its founders, Friends Care continues to strive to provide a friendly, vibrant and home-like environment. We continuously improve programs, services and the campus, while keeping a deep commitment to our mission and vision and planning for the future needs of seniors in our community and region.
